## CALL FOR PAPERS

The Jonathan Edwards Center at Ridley College in Melbourne, Australia, in collaboration with JECs worldwide, invites you to submit a proposal for a paper to be read at the Jonathan Edwards Congress (August 24-28, 2015).

The Congress will highlight the global impact of Edwards and the eighteenth century revivals, and explore the ways in which his texts and teachings are received in the contemporary world. We anticipate that every continent will be represented at JEDCON 2015.

An abstract for each proposal should be around 250 words and sent to Rhys Bezzant, Director of the JEC Australia before November 1, 2014 at [jec@ridley.edu.au](mailto:jec@ridley.edu.au). Submissions should include the author's name, affiliation, email address, title of abstract, body of abstract, and a short CV.

Papers read at the Congress should be approximately forty minutes in length, from which several will be selected for inclusion in an edited volume of conference proceedings.

Keynotes for the Congress include Ken Minkema, Doug Sweeney, Gerald McDermott, Harry Stout, Stuart Piggin, and Adriaan Neele. There will also be a stream for ministry practitioners to present a paper connecting the texts and teachings of Edwards to their own pastoral experiences, context and challenges.
